

# Chinese Language Class

The **South Pasadena Chinese-American Club (SPCC)** will again be offering our afterschool Chinese language program. The course offerings for Fall of 2016 continue from our Spring 2016 instruction. Starting **Fall 2016**, a beginner class and an advanced

beginner class will be offered. The advanced beginner class is designed for students who attended the Spring 2016 beginner class or who have some exposure to the Chinese language.



### Fall 2016 – dates and times to be announced (TBA).

Each class will meet twice a week, with optional tutoring sessions offered an additional two days a week. The location is still pending.

**Beginner class** is for students with little or no exposure to the Chinese language who are entering kindergarten or first grade.

**CLASS:** Tuesday & Thursday (3:15 p.m. to 5:15 p.m.)

**TUTORING:** Monday & Wednesday (3:15 p.m. to 5:15 p.m.)

**Advanced beginner class** is for students with some exposure to the Chinese language (such as our returning students from Spring 2016) who are entering first grade or second grade.

**CLASS:** Monday & Wednesday (3:15 p.m. to 5:15 p.m.)

**TUTORING:** Tuesday & Thursday (3:15 p.m. to 5:15 p.m.)

**TUITION:** \$595 (Current SPCC Members\*) / \$695 (Non-SPCC Members)

Registration will be on a first-come, first-served basis, with priority for returning students and SPCC members.
